RESUMEN DEL CURSO - EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Objective

The objective of this course is to provide advanced students with the opportunity to practice their English skills at a challenging level through the use of pop culture topics, current events, and multimedia source material.

The course content will allow the student to engage in debates and lively conversations about a wide variety of subjects.

Solution

Candidates that wish to enroll in this course will have to accredit a minimum C1 level of English according to the European Language Framework.

The course has been devised as a 60-hour long, semester course divided into self-contained weekly units, which means that they are not chronologically tied nor do they offer cumulative content.

In-class work will be heavily focused, obviously, in oral practice. A certain degree of homework is expected, such as listening activities, the reading of texts, etc., in order to optimize class time. These activities have the sole aim of providing the student with information so they will come better prepared for class.
